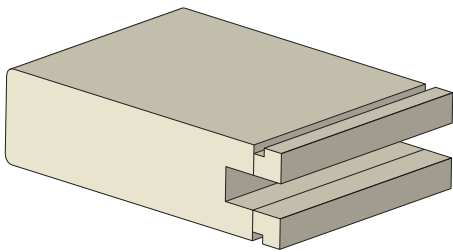


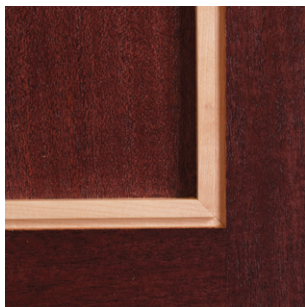

Detail of Quirk Moulding in MDF



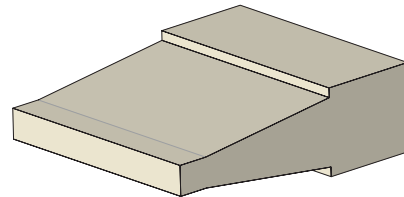
TS3000 in Mahogany with Maple Quirk Moulding (QM) and Flat (C) Panel



TS3000 in MDF with Bevel (BV) Sticking and Senior Bevel (F) Panel



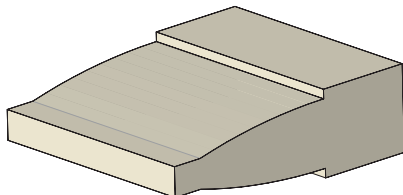
